Descripción del problema encontrado: Se han encontrado dos productos no autorizados, siendo promocionados como productos naturales para el realce sexual, los cuales contienen activos de prescripción que no fueron declaradas y otras sustancias que pueden plantear serios riesgos para la salud. De acuerdo a la investigación realizada por la DNM No se encontró registro sanitario alguno ni importaciones de los productos.

La DNM alerta a toda la población a abstenerse de adquirir y/o suministrar éstos producto, en virtud de que su uso representa un riesgo para la salud de la persona que lo consuma. En razón de que los productos Wonderblue y B-Hard on Demand NO cumplen con los requerimientos de calidad que avale su seguridad, calidad y eficacia.

La DNM recomienda no adquirir este tipo de producto ya que puede generar un riesgo a la salud. Así mismo recuerda adquirir los medicamentos en lugares autorizados por la DNM. Cualquier duda puede recurrir a ésta Dirección llamando al teléfono gratuito 136.

Se informa que la DNM continuará las acciones de vigilancia, como el aseguramiento de productos, para evitar la venta de los mismos porque representan un riesgo a la población.

Health Canada has seized two unauthorized products being promoted as natural health products for sexual enhancement from Désirs et Plaisirs in St-Jérôme, Quebec. These products were found to contain undeclared prescription drug substances and other drug substances that may pose serious risks to the health of Canadians.

Background

Thiodimethylsildenafil and thiomethisosildenafil are unauthorized substances similar to sildenafil.

Products containing sildenafil should only be used under the supervision of a healthcare practitioner. Sildenafil should never be used by individuals taking any kind of nitrate drug (e.g. nitroglycerine) as it can cause potentially life-threatening low blood pressure. Individuals with heart problems, including high blood pressure, a history of heart attack, stroke, abnormal heart beat or chest pain, are at higher risk of cardiovascular side effects. Other possible side effects of using sildenafil include headache, facial flushing, indigestion, dizziness, abnormal vision and hearing loss.
